Registration and Background Checks

The deadline to submit your registration and t-shirt orders is June 16, 2019. Please make sure to include your camper list. This will ensure that each camper will have a bunk for the week. Anyone 18 and over planning to stay on the camp grounds **must** complete the application for a background check. The background check is paid by the applicant when you submit your application and the cost is \$12.95. These must be completed by July 25, 2019. Also, each camper must have an Activity Participation Agreement completed and the church coordinator is to hold onto these throughout the week. Cost per camper

As always, camp is free to anyone that wants to come. At the same time, camp has its costs and any donations are welcome. While we do not charge a fee to come to camp, we have estimated that it costs approximately \$60.00 per camper for the week.
